



SCHOOL UNIFORMS

In order to maintain the high standard of school dress, parents are requested to help the school to make sure all students are properly attired when coming to school. The message that we are trying to convey is that students, just like adults, when going to work, dress accordingly.

Primary/Junior School Dress Code KG – Grade 6

Boys: Daily Uniform

- Blue Trousers or shorts with blue & white striped shirt displaying the school crest on the front and school jumper if required.
- Black comfortable shoes/sandals with white socks.

Girls: Daily Uniform

- KG and Grade 1 dress only.
- Grade 2 and 3 dress or culottes and a blouse.
- Grade 4 to 6 dress or culottes and a blouse or trousers and shirt.
- The school jumper may be worn in the cold weather.
- Black comfortable shoes/sandals with white socks.
- If a hair band for ponytails is required, it should be made from the same materials as the uniform.

Boys and Girls Physical Education (PE) Uniform

- Red Polo Shirt and Blue shorts for all students.
- A blue tracksuit is also available for the cooler month.

High School Dress Code – Grade 7– 13

Boys: Daily Uniform

- Blue Trousers, pale blue short sleeved shirts with the school logo on the front.
- Black leather shoes with navy or black socks.
- Black Belt for Trousers.

Girls: Daily Uniform

- Blue Skirt (ankle length or knee length) or blue trousers, light blue fitted or straight shirt.
- Black leather shoes with white shocks.

Boys and Girls Physical Education (PE) Uniform

- The Sports Polo Shirt is white with red trim, with the School Logo, and is available for Girls & Boys.
- Boys and Girls should wear the red Shorts
- Students must wear trainers for all sports, and it is important that these have “non-marking soles”, this is particularly necessary when using the Sports Hall.
