As guided by the PYP Standards and Practices, the Elementary School at EISM will:

- Establish a firm foundation in the core subjects of Language A (English), Math, Social Studies and Science (through the Units of Inquiry)
- Enrich the curriculum through Specialist classes that connect to the Units of Inquiry including Arabic, the Arts (visual and performance), Technology, Library, Personal, Social and Physical Education and Islamic Education for Muslim students.
- Enable students to promote their own international mindedness through the Learner Profile and the opportunity to take action.
- Respond to the individual intellectual, physical, emotional and social needs of students.
- From EY1 to Year 6, students follow the IB's Enhanced Primary Years Program (Enhanced PYP) which is a framework for learning important knowledge, concepts and skills as well as a philosophy of education into which the elementary curriculum fits.
